Questions on experiences with mHealth

** Every time a rating was asked. The participants were asked to give a number anywhere from 0 to 10, with 0 being very negative, 5 neutral and 10 very positive.*

- **What is your experience with mHealth?**
 - What is the most positive quality or application of mHealth?
 - What is the most negative quality or application of mHealth?
 - If you had to rate from 0 to 10, what is your attitude towards the current mHealth possibilities? Why this number?
 - If you had to rate from 0 to 10, How much confidence do you have in the current mHealth technology? (More specific stance on reliability, safety, accuracy of the technology in general) Why this number?

Questions on current challenges in the use of mHealth

- If you had to rate from 0 to 10, how well is mHealth currently integrated in daily practice? Why this number?
 - What is needed to implement mHealth as optimal as possible?
 - What are the challenges and points of attention for implementing mHealth?
- What are the biggest challenges in the use of mHealth in daily practice at this moment? (which we have not already discussed)
- Are cost being saved with mHealth at this moment and how will this be in the future?
- Does mHealth add to the quality of care at this moment and how will this be in the future?
- How do you see the role of mHealth in the future? Positive or negative? And why?
- Is there anything concerning mHealth that you would like to add which we have not discussed already?
